Your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

Thank you for your request dated the 29th December 2022. We can confirm that the Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent Integrated Care Board does hold some of the information that you have requested. Please see our responses in blue below:

I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) to request information relating to the provision of ADHD (Attention deficit hyperactivity disorder) services by NHS Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent ICB.

- 1. Please name the organisation(s) that deliver(s) CYP (children and young people) ADHD assessment / diagnoses in your ICB area?**

Midlands Partnership NHS Foundation Trust (MPFT) and North Staffordshire Combined Healthcare NHS Trust (NSCHT).

- a) When did the contract(s) begin and when is the contract(s) due to end?**

Rolling contract for over ten years for CAMHS that includes assessment of ADHD.

- b) What is the annual spend for this service for 2022, and for the last 5 years?**

Rolling contract for over 10 years for adult services that includes assessment of ADHD for MPFT/NSCHT. Dr J & Co contract started on the 1st July 2022 for 12 months with an optional 12 month extension clause.

- b) What is the annual spend for this service for 2022, and for the last 5 years?**

Spend is not itemised that is specific to ADHD, please redirect to MPFT and NSCHT. This is commercially sensitive information under Section 43 of the Freedom of Information Act in relation to Dr J and Co which the ICB is unable to share.

- c) How is the service contracted – is it Block, Activity-based, or AQP contracting?**

Block for MPFT/NSCHT. For Dr J and Co the contract is activity based.

- d) If the service is commissioned with other CCGs, ICSs or Trusts, which are these?**

No.

No service is not commissioned against activity numbers.
