Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and thank you for your email dated 28th August clarifying the request. We can now confirm that Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent Integrated Care Board can provide the following information.

You have requested:

I am writing under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to request information about the Lung Cancer Screening (previously Targeted Lung Health Check) programmes in your ICB.

1. Do you have a Lung Cancer Screening [LCS] (or formerly Targeted Lung Health Check [TLHC]) programme running in your ICB region? *Yes*

LCS is available to the whole eligible population of Staffordshire and Stoke on Trent via patient direct access. Eligibility is determined by clinical factors etc set by the national team. This supplements roll out invitations of eligible people largely based on area of residence / GP practice. The initial roll out is complete for the Stoke-on-Trent, North Staffordshire and the Stafford areas and is underway for the remainder of the ICB. Newly eligible patients are enrolled as they become eligible. Eligible people who opted not to participate can re-enrol at any time.

- b. Commissioner of the service (i.e. name of the ICB, NHS Trust, Cancer Alliance etc. who is leading on the programme in the ICB)**

West Midlands Cancer Alliance
