Within Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent there will be 3 CDCs, all are delivered and managed by different Acute Trusts.

Sir Robert Peel Hospital, Tamworth, is a Spoke CDC, Provided by University Hospital Derby and Burton (UHDB). For services that are provided this will need to be requested from UHDB. Email: uhdb.foi@nhs.net

Cannock Chase Hospital, Cannock, is a Standard CDC, Provided by The Royal Wolverhampton Hospital (RWT). For services that are provided this will need to be requested from RWT. Email: rwh-tr.foi@nhs.net

Hanley, Stoke-on-Trent, is a Hub CDC, Provided by University Hospital North Midlands (UHNM), this CDC is due to go fully live in February 2025 however some diagnostic services are currently available. For services that are provided this will need to be requested from UHNM. Email: foi@uhn.nhs.uk
