Thank you for your request for information received on the 8th August 2023. We can confirm that the Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent Integrated Care Board can provide the following information.

Under the Freedom of information act, please could you provide me with the following information.

The person who holds the job title or responsibility for the following within NHS Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent ICB :

1. Clinical Lead for Oncology Services

Under current arrangements the responsibility for the commissioning of Oncology Services remain with NHS England and therefore Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent ICB have neither a designated clinical lead nor a programme lead for Oncology Services.

The ICB does however have a responsibility for performance matters relating to cancer services and this responsibility is held by the Portfolio Director for Planned Care and Cancer.

2. Programme Lead for Oncology Services

See response to question one above.

3. Programme Director for Connected Care or similar role (gives health and care professionals and local people shared online access to records and data through digital enabled projects)

Kaustav Mukherjee, is the ICB's One Health and Care Shared Care Record Programme Lead.

4. Programme Director for Virtual Wards

Virtual Wards is not an ICB programme but rather it is owned and managed through an ICS Provider Collaborative arrangement.

David Smith, Transformation Project Manager at University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust is the lead Project Manager for the Remote Care Programme, one element of which is the Virtual Wards programme.

5. Director for Digital Transformation

Sally Deacon is the Director for Digital Transformation within the Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent ICB.

6. Head of Virtual Wards

Virtual Wards is not an ICB programme but rather it is owned and managed through a ICS Provider Collaborative arrangement.

Helen Ashley, Director of Strategy and Transformation at University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust is the Chair of the Remote Care Programme Board, one element of which is the Virtual Wards programme.

7. Head of Connected Care or similar role (gives health and care professionals and local people shared online access to records and data through digital enabled projects)

Chris Ibell, Chief Digital Officer of the Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent ICB is responsible overall for all aspects of Digital, Data and Technology, of which Connected Care is one element.
