NHS Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent ICB do commission Community Dermatology Services. The total number of patients treated is information that is not held by the ICB.

2. Who are the Community Dermatology Service Providers commissioned by the Integrated Care Board? Can you please provide the number of patients treated by each provider within the last 12 months?

The Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent ICB only commission one company who is HEALTH HARMONIE LTD. This contract commenced on the 1<sup>st</sup> June 2021. The number of patients treated is information that is not held by the ICB.

Our Community Dermatology Service is not contracted to provide patients with Biologic therapies.

Patients that require Biologic Therapy will be transferred to an Acute Hospital Provider by our community provider, in accordance with the service specification.
