Your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

Thank you for your email dated Wednesday 16th September 2025 for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. We can now confirm that Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent Integrated Care Board can provide the following information.

An anonymised copy of this response will be made publicly available on the ICB website. The ICBs response is provided below in blue text.

You have requested:

In February 2023 a representative of Integrated Care Board (Transformation) attended a public meeting of local councillors and patients of the GP service that was closing because you wanted to close the (temporary) health centre adjacent to Burntwood Leisure Centre.

At that meeting it was again restated that the new (replacement for the temporary building) health centre would be open in 2025.

Question1. What was the then plan being proposed that would mean the facility would be open by the end of 2025, was it just for a health centre or was their extra buildings, and if so, what were they to be?

The scheme is a Staffordshire County Council scheme. The ICB's interest is in relation to the health care facility only. Any information in relation to extra buildings will be held by Staffordshire County Council as the landowners of the site.

Question 2. What is involved in the current plan yet to be formally submitted to the local planning authority? Does it include any other development (buildings) beside the promised health centre?

As above, the ICB's interest is in relation to the health care facility only. Information regarding other buildings will be held by Staffordshire County Council.

If you are dissatisfied with the response, you are entitled to request an internal review which should be formally requested in writing and must be within two calendar months from the date this response was issued.
