  - **Could you please tell me when it received the funding, or when it is set to receive it?**

  - **Could you also please specify how much total funding the ICS has received for this purpose?**

£212,000
- **Could you also please provide a list of these models, specifying when they were established/are due to be established, the amount of funding allocated for each, and WTE staff approved for each?**

Funding passed to North Staffordshire Combined Healthcare NHS Trust and Midlands Partnership University NHS Foundation Trust based on relative need. The ICB commissioned an outcome based service and there WTE information not available.
