Thank you for your request dated the 8th March 2023. We can confirm that the Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent Integrated Care Board does hold some of the information that you have requested. Please see our responses in blue below:

Wilmington Healthcare is researching how maternal vaccinations are delivered across the NHS. Could you please answer the following questions:

- 1. Can you please provide the number of sites within your organisation that provide the following services:
 - Tdap (Pertussis)/whooping cough vaccination to pregnant women: hospital-based sites

University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) provide influenza vaccinations to pregnant women.

All 143 GP Practices in the ICB are able to offer vaccinations. Community Pharmacies are also able to undertake vaccinations if signed up to the NHS England Enhanced Service, but we do not hold this information.
