Thank you for your request dated the 5th July 2023. We can confirm that the Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent Integrated Care Board does hold the information that you have requested.

You have requested:

I would like to request the following information from your ICB:

- 1 *What did your ICB spend on delivery of the tobacco dependence treatment programme in maternity, mental health inpatient and acute inpatient in the financial year 2021/22 in each Trust?***

Delivery is the responsibility of each organisation within the Integrated Care System.
The ICB did not exist in 2021/2022.

- 2 *What did your ICB spend on delivery of the tobacco dependence treatment programme in maternity, mental health inpatient and acute inpatient in the financial year 2022/23 in each Trust?***

Delivery is the responsibility of each organisation within the Integrated Care System.

- 3 *What is the allocated budget for delivery of the tobacco dependence treatment programme in maternity, mental health inpatient and acute inpatient for the financial year 2023/24 in each Trust?***

Inpatient Allocation	£	371,000
Maternity Allocation	£	152,000
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Total Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent Allocation	£	523,000

4 What is the planned budget for delivery of the tobacco dependence treatment programme in maternity, mental health inpatient and acute inpatient for the financial year 2024/25 in each Trust?

NHSE funding allocations are not due until 1 April 2024.

5 In the financial year 2023/24 is their allocated budget for any other smoking cessation activity within the ICB across NHS Trusts e.g. NHS staff, community mental health, outpatients and what is that allocated budget?

There is no other allocated budget for smoking cessation activity other than that outlined at Question 3 above.
