Your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

Thank you for your request for information received on the 7th December 2023. We can confirm that the Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent Integrated Care Board can provide the following information.

Please see our responses in blue below:

I want to request information about community diagnostic centres operational across your ICB under the Freedom of Information Act.

1. Could you please let me know how many community diagnostic centres are open across the ICB.

Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent ICB are looking to implement three community diagnostic centres (CDC) across the system. Stoke-on-Trent CDC is due to open on the 30th March 2025.

2. Please could you tell me the postcode of their respective locations, and what date they were first operational.

The CDC for Cannock (WS11 5XY) opened in 2022 with the recognition that further estates work is required on the Cannock Chase hospital site to incorporate new permanent facilities, the lead organisations for this CDC are Black Country ICB and Royal Wolverhampton NHS Trust.

Similar position for Sir Robert Peel (B78 3NG) building upon existing resources and incorporation of mobile capacity, the lead organisations for this CDC are Derby and Derbyshire ICB and University Hospitals of Derby and Burton NHS Trust.

University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust are leading the business case and implementation of the CDC whilst there are some diagnostics already available the date to be fully operational is expected to be March 2024 therefore no detail can be provided in relation to the further questions.

3. Could you tell me the number of appointments they have fulfilled per month since opening.
