Thank you for your request for information received on 18th March 2025. We can confirm that the Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent Integrated Care Board can provide the following information.

An anonymised copy of this response will be made publicly available on the ICB website. Please note the ICBs responses in blue.

I am writing to request some information on the numbers of the following procedures carried out on average per year:

- Hemorrhage/Bleeding (emergency embolisations)
- Elective embolisation for tumours / hyperplasia
- Arteriovenous malformation
- Aneurysm
- Pelvic congestion syndrome
- Endoleaks

The FOI request is a mixture of conditions and procedures:

- **In order for the ICB to be able to pull a data report we require more specific information in relation to the procedures that are being requested.**
- **The ICB doesn't hold data on the number of conditions that have been diagnosed**

To request an internal review
