Cervical screening and HPV vaccination can help prevent cancer

Cervical cancer is one of the most preventable cancers, yet in England two women die every day from it.

HPV vaccination and cervical screening can help prevent, and one day end cervical cancer. However, uptake has been falling in many parts of the country.

If you missed your HPV vaccination in school, you can still receive a HPV vaccination for free on the NHS up until your 25th birthday. Please contact your GP.






